Championship

The events will be a rounds of the **SDMC CLOSED TO CLUB SUMMER SERIES**

Method of Marking

The method of marking shall be in accordance with TSR22B

Eligibility

Open to **Adult / Youth** members of Scarborough and District Motor Club who hold a current ACU Affiliated Membership Card. Guest riders may ride.

Course

The course **Will not** include the use of Public Roads. The number of sections and the number of laps will be announced at the start.

Entries

Entries will be taken at the start if accompanied by the entry fee of £10.00 for adults and £5.00 for youth entrants which includes the ACU subscription, EYC levy and Drivers third party risks and personal accident off road insurance. Guest riders £12.00

Awards To qualify for an award the rider must have competed and finished in at least 3 rounds.
