SCARBOROUGH 2 DAY TRIAL 2016

Supplementary Regulations for an Adult and Youth solo Trial to be held on **Sat/Sun 6th 7th August 2016**, at Low North Park, Harwood Dale, Scarborough North Yorkshire YO13 OLA

1. Jurisdiction. The trial will be run under the ACU National Sporting Code and Standing Regulations for Trials, together with these Supplementary Regulations and any further instructions issued.
2. Competitors Eligible. All Adult and Youth Riders who hold a current (2016) ACU Affiliated Membership Card, and member of an ACU affiliated Club.

3 Courses: HARD COURSE, EASY COURSE, AND VERY EASY COURSE **(including Electric Bikes)**

Also a Conducted Course for any riders (and Electric Bikes)

N.B. (usual ACU Bike Restrictions/Age Classes etc will apply for Youth Riders)

3. The course on private land will be clearly marked and the onus of finding all sections rests entirely with the riders. Numbers of laps to be stated at the time.
4. Observed Sections will be clearly marked and numbered. Each rider shall attempt every section in numerical order on each lap depending on instructions as to first section to be attempted.
5. Penalties. As per the Standing Regulations.
6. Awards. Best performance in each class plus 1st Class Award to the next 10% of the entry in each class and 2nd Class Awards to the next 10% of the entry in each class. **All Youth finishers receive an award.**
7. Entries to be made on the Official Entry Form and sent to the Secretary of the meeting not later than the **closing date – Sunday 31st July** with entry fee of **£25.00**, **Any information regarding the trial will be posted on the website. www.scarboroughdmc.co.uk**. If you require confirmation of receipt of entry please provide an email address, thank you.
8. Start. The trial will start at **11am on Saturday and 10 am on Sunday**.
9. Riders numbers must be displayed on the rider's machine.
10. Scrutineering will commence at 8.45 am on Saturday and finish at 10.45am. All machines, clothing, and helmets must be submitted for examination each day. Any machine failing to comply with ACU regulations will not be allowed to start and the entry fee will not be refunded.
11. **Camping Facilities.** Available at venue for the duration of event only (from Friday). Toilets are available, but **no** electrics, and **no** water. Anyone intending to camp should inform the secretary of the meeting when entering the event. The venue to be vacated by the mid-day on Monday 8th August 2016. Refreshments are will be available. **Strictly no FIRES!**
