In April and May 2015, two large earthquakes hit Nepal. The country suffered huge amounts of damage and loss of life which will end up pushing at least an additional 700,000 people further into poverty. It is estimated that the overall impact of the earthquakes on the Nepali tourism industry, will be a reduction of about 40% over the next 12 months.

In June 2017, I will be part of a World Challenge team from Scalby School, travelling to Nepal, to directly contribute to the restoration work in these communities, work that includes rebuilding their schools.

We will be living as part of the community interacting socially with the locals, and focusing on different fun and educational activities for the children.

Personally I feel this will be a brilliant life changing experience for me to be able to offer help to people who have suffered such devastation. To make it possible for me to accomplish this World Challenge, I will be undertaking different fundraising activities over the next months to fund this opportunity. As part of this trip we also hope to take part in trekking expeditions, white water rafting and a jungle safari.
