Announcement: The Scarborough & DMC Club will organise a National Trial held under the National Sporting Code, The Standing Trials Regulations of the ACU, the British Youth C&D Trials Championship Regulations and any final instructions that may be issued.

Acceptable formats are post, email or website but in addition for every event a set of provisional results must be sent, either by post or by email, to the Permit Issuing Authority (ACU). These must clearly show the date and time of publication.

Start: The start will be at 10 am

The first rider will start at 10 am the remainder as per Championship Regulations

Approximate length of course - number of laps: 3 laps - 2 miles
