

Appendix 1 – organising Club – Scarborough & DMC Restricted Club Trials under ACU – Covid – 19 Restrictions and Guidelines –

To comply with the ACU and Government specific conditions, Scarborough & DMC will be following the below Rules, Restrictions, and Guidelines for Covid 19 – Please Read ALL – The Rules need to be adhered to ensure the event remains safe. Covid Restrictions and Guidelines may change and we will continue to monitor the current situation.

No Spectators are allowed – non-riding Officials, Riders and Observers only

Vehicles – Only one rider to attend in a vehicle unless accompanied by another Adult Rider or Observer from the same household. Please do not share vehicles outside your household, even if everyone have entries. Also strictly one ride to one bike.

Social Distancing – All attendees to SDMC events to comply where possible with the 2 metre distance rule. Face Coverings to be worn were appropriate.

Anyone who has experienced (or is experiencing) COVID 19 symptoms within 14 days prior to the event must NOT attend the event.

If any Riders, Official or Observer should become unwell during the event they must notify the Secretary or Clerk of Course by mobile phone if possible and will be required to leave the venue immediately.

Entries – A maximum number of entries may be set by the organisers in order to apply appropriate social distancing and safe parking must be adhered to at the venue.

NO ONE DAY LICENCES WILL BE ISSUED

ENTRIES ONLY BY THE ACU ON LINE SYSTEM – NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY – NO CASH HANDLED ON THE DAY. IF THE EVENT IS CANCELLED THE ACU WILL DEDUCT £3.00 HANDING FEE ON THE REFUND.

RIDER NUMBERS – these will be available for you to collect at the event, social distance measures will be in place. Please do not congregate with other riders whilst at the event, including whilst collecting your Rider Number. – *to be confirmed please check our website & facebook page.*

Course Setting Out Team – PPE gloves must be worn when handling markers and social distancing must be observed.

Parking at the venue – Please respect other people when parking and leave a suitable distance between each vehicle.

Observers – Must be fully briefed with reference to Social Distancing etc, Observer Boards will be prepared and placed at the section prior to the event. Observers must position themselves in a safe position for themselves and the riders. The Observer Boards and Flags to be collected up and returned at a suitably marked place near the Huts and disinfected.

Riders Arriving at Sections – only 6 riders allowed in a section at any one time to walk the sections, walk in one direction from start to finish, must keep moving to prevent a hold up and

return to their motorbike via a different route. Riders must keep 2 metres apart from other riders and observers and should only pass another rider if they can keep a 2 metre distance.

Riders must immediately evacuate the section if instructed by Observer

Only small groups of riders – maximum of 6 to arrive at a section at once.

Riders MUST travel to each section and attempt them in order.

Riders MUST wait or park at least 2 metres away from any other rider whilst queuing at sections.

After completing the section the riders should move away from others and continue onto the next section. There must be no group congregating of riders.

If a rider falls from their machine in the section, the rider should make every attempt to clear the section without help, In emergency or if help is needed, please use Social Distancing where possible. Youth Riders – Parents/Guardians ONLY to assist the Rider.

Riders risk being automatically disqualified and could face ACU disciplinary action if they do not obey the Social Distancing Rules.

If you feel that you are prevented by these restrictions to travel to our event please contact us as soon as possible, either by Telephone or Email, we can then arrange to refund the Entry Fee. They will NOT BE GIVEN to anyone who does NOT contact us before the event.
