- Jurisdiction. The trial will be run under the ACU National Sporting Code and Standing Regulations for Trials, together with these Supplementary Regulations and any further instructions issued.
- 2. Competitors Eligible. All Adults and Youth Riders who hold a current 2024 ACU Affiliated Licence and a member of an ACU affiliated Club.

- 3. The course will be on private land and be clearly marked and the onus of finding all sections rests entirely with the rider. Number of Sections and Laps to be confirmed at the time of event.
- 4. Observed Sections will be clearly marked and numbered. Each rider shall attempt every section in numerical order on each lap depending on instructions as to first section to be attempted.
- 5. Penalties. As per the Standing Regulations. METHOD OF MARKING TSR22A STOP PERMITTED
- 6. Awards 1st, 2nd, 3rd in each class. All Youth Finishers receive an Award.
- 7. Entries to be made on the SCARBOROUGH & DMC On Line Entry Site <u>Closing date Sunday</u> <u>July 27th 2024</u> or before if the maximum entry of 150 riders + 10 Conducted is reached, with Entry Fee of £40 Adult £30 Youth £15 Conducted. - 8. Start. The trial will start at **11 am on Saturday and 10 am on Sunday, time limit will be confirmed before the event.**
- 9. Rider numbers can be collected from the hatch at the office and must be clearly shown on your machine.
- 10. Machine Examination will commence at 8.45 am on Saturday and finish at 10.45 am, and from 8.15 am Sunday, machines, clothing, and helmets must be submitted for examination each day. Any machine failing to comply with the ACU Regulations will not be allowed to start and the Entry Fee will not be refunded.
- 11. Time. Riders will be penalised 1 mark per minute up to a maximum of 20 minutes for late start, after which they will be deemed non-starters. (and 1 mark per minute up to a maximum of 20 minutes for late finishers if a time limit is used)

Dual Lane Trial

All riders entered in the Observation Trial are eligible to register for the Dual Lane trial to be held on Sunday after the Observation Trial. Entry is optional. There will be Two Classes: Adult and Youth. **All riders wishing to compete must register with the Secretary of the Meeting prior to 6pm.** This knock-out event will take place over a Single Section clearly marked as a double lane. Riders will be paired and will ride the section simultaneously. In addition to any marks lost on observation the following will apply.

- First rider finished 0 Mark
- Second rider finished 1 Mark

If both riders arrive with the same marks lost, then the Section will be immediately repeated. The rider with the lowest loss of Marks will proceed in the competition and the rider with the higher score will be eliminated. When two riders are left the winner will be decided by the best of three rides. **Starting the Section**.

The starter will raise his arm when the riders are ready to start, and the riders are permitted to start only when the starter drops his arm.
