Venue: Low North Park, Harwood Dale, Scarborough N. Yorkshire YO13 0LA Camping: We allow camping from Friday until after the event, the Camp must be vacated by the evening of MONDAY 5th AUGUST, there is a Practice/Training Day for Youth Riders taking place on Monday 5th, start time 10am, so please avoid the area if practicing. Please park in the designated Camping Area which will be clearly marked. No charge for camping but we will have a Donation Box with all donations to a Charity. Thank you! There will be members of the Committee Camping should anything urgent occur. Please take your rubbish home with you. There is no electricity supply and no water supply so bring your supplies. Toilets will be available on site. Can we ask that you refrain from emptying your Portaloos into our Toilets. We don't allow the use of Jet Washers for cleaning bikes at Low North Camp. Please drive slowly and carefully both in the camp and through the villages. Thank you for your co-operation.

METHOD OF MARKING TSR22A STOP PERMITTED

RETIREMENTS any rider who retires or is injured please inform the Secretary of the Meeting before leaving the venue. **This makes Results a whole lot easier and quicker.** And also any Incidents/Accidents please inform the Secretary.

Held under the National Sporting Code, the Standing Regulations of the ACU the Supplementary Regulations and Final Instructions.

- 1. Number of laps, sections and time limits to be confirmed on the day
- 2. Any rider not starting at his/her start time will be penalised one mark per minute upto 20 minutes, after which they will be a non-starter
- 3. The Car Park and Start Area is a SILENT ZONE No Starting of engines will be permitted until instructed to do so by an official
- 4. Parent and Guardians will NOT be permitted to walk the sections doing so may result in disqualification.
- 5. Only competitors are allowed in the Observed Section until a '5' penalty has occurred, only then may the rider be assisted.
- 6. Please advise the Secretary of any non-starter, retirements, accidents or incidents etc.

Dual Lane Trial

All riders entered in the Observation Trial are eligible to register for the Dual Lane trial to be held on Saturday evening – Start 6:30pm and Sunday after the trial. Entry is optional. There will be Two Classes: Adult and Youth.

All riders wishing to compete must register with the Secretary of the Meeting prior to 6pm on the Saturday.

This knock-out event will take place over a Single Section clearly marked as a double lane. Riders will be paired and will ride the section simultaneously. In addition to any marks lost on observation the following will apply.

- First rider finished 0 Mark
- Second rider finished 1 Mark

If both riders arrive with the same marks lost, then the Section will be immediately repeated. The rider with the lowest loss of Marks will proceed in the competition and the rider with the higher score will be eliminated. When two riders are left the winner will be decided by the best of three rides.

Starting the Section.

The starter will raise his arm when the riders are ready to start, and the riders are permitted to start only when the starter drops his arm.
